Microsoft License Mobility through Software Assurance – How to verify your existing MS Server Appliance licenses

---

Eligible Microsoft Windows Server Applications can be deployed on FUJITSU Cloud Service S5 using existing application licenses. This allows customers to more easily move their workloads to the FUJITSU Cloud Service S5 cloud, without any additional Microsoft software licensing fees. This benefit is available to Microsoft Volume Licensing (VL) customers with eligible server applications covered by active Microsoft Software Assurance (SA) contracts. Not only will license mobility make the transition easier for existing SA customers, it provides customers who prefer to purchase perpetual licenses the ability to continue doing so while still taking advantage of the efficiencies of the cloud..

All customers using License Mobility through Software Assurance must complete a license verification process and Microsoft will ensure that the customer has eligible licenses with active Software Assurance. Microsoft will provide confirmation to the customer and to the service provider that the customer has completed this verification process. The customer may deploy their application server software prior to the verification process being completed; the customer is responsible for managing true ups (*Microsoft's Enterprise Agreement annual license submission*) and renewals as required under their agreement.

## Eligibility Requirements:

To take advantage of this benefit, the following conditions must apply:

1. All Microsoft Server application products migrated to FUJITSU Cloud Service S5 through the License Mobility through Software Assurance program must be covered with active Software Assurance (SA).
2. The server applications must be on the following list of eligible products:
  - Microsoft Exchange Server
  - Microsoft SharePoint Server
  - Microsoft SQL Server Standard Edition
  - Microsoft SQL Server Enterprise Edition
  - Microsoft Lync Server
  - Microsoft System Center Server
  - Microsoft Dynamics CRM Server

This section of the PUR also contains additional restrictions that apply to customers' participation in the License Mobility through Software Assurance program

3. Eligible Volume Licensing programs include the Enterprise Agreement, Enterprise Subscription Agreement, and Microsoft Open Value Agreement, where Software Assurance is included, and other Volume Licensing programs where Software Assurance is an option, such as Microsoft Open License or Select Plus.

4. The customer must maintain appropriate Client Access Licenses (CALs) with Software Assurance in their Microsoft Volume Licensing agreement for accessing the application servers.
5. Licence Mobility does not include the Microsoft Windows Client operating system, Desktop application products (e.g. Microsoft Office), nor Microsoft Windows Server operating system. When deploying a Microsoft Windows Server, customers are restricted to using a FUJITSU Cloud Service S5 Windows Server License and cannot apply their own license.
6. When looking to use validated licenses, customers MUST NOT deploy a FUJITSU Cloud Service S5 VM Application Server VM template. Instead customer must deploy a base Microsoft Windows Operating System VM and then install the application using own media.
7. In order to comply with Microsoft’s “server farm” rules, licenses deployed in a specific FUJITSU Cloud Service S5 Region cannot be moved to another FUJITSU Cloud Service S5 Region for 90 days. 8. Under Microsoft “per core” licence model, four core licenses are required for each virtual machine:
